### Learning is fun!

The students have settled back into routines after the Easter break and are actively engaged in learning. On Fridays they are continuing to develop their skills in coding and manipulating digital devices in Mr Bennett's Technology lessons.



In Geography, the students have been learning cartography skills and concepts. As part of a game "Where in the World am I" they had to have an understanding of latitude lines such as Equator, Tropic of Cancer, Tropic of Capricorn, Arctic Circle and Antarctic Circle. They also used longitude lines – International Date Line and the Prime Meridian Line. Given clues the students had to pinpoint either a continent, a country or a body of water.

Welcome back for Term 2 it is great to see all have returned ready to learn. This term in English our overall focus is retell, looking at events at the beginning, middle and end of stories.
